- Provide backstage support during show week, including quick changes, repairs, and ironing.

- Budget management sourcing cost-effective costumes while maintaining high production value.
- Basic sewing and alteration skills ability to make minor costume adjustments and repairs.
- **Organisation and time management** coordinating fittings, sourcing items, and keeping track of multiple costume pieces.
- **Communication skills** working closely with the Director, cast, and production team to meet costume needs.
- **Problem-solving** ability to make quick fixes during performances and adapt to last-minute costume issues.

- All costumes sourced and fitted at least two weeks before opening night.
- Costume budget adhered to within a 10% variance.
